Université Paris Dauphine

In the city of Paris, Université Paris-Dauphine is a public university specialized in Organization and Decision Sciences, recognized for its multi-disciplinary approach, by its stakeholders on national and international levels.



Its 11,000 students are spread out as follows: 35% in undergraduate programs, over 60% in Master & Ph.D programs and 5% in Executive Education. 23% of the total number are international students, representing 40 countries. Students are encouraged to participate in a variety of

activities through more than 40 student associations on campus and 30 athletic disciplines.

Paris-Dauphine has developed international relationships with 314 top-ranked universities across the world. The university holds close ties to the business world: internships, apprenticeship contracts and research chairs, corporate partnerships are merely a few examples of Paris-Dauphine and the business community working together.

In 2009, Paris-Dauphine became the first and the only French university to obtain the European Quality Improvement System (EQUIS) accreditation, which is awarded in recognition of Academic Excellence.
