KU Leuven (Catholic University of Leuven/*Katholieke Universiteit Leuven*) is Belgium's largest and highest-ranked university and, founded in 1425, one of the oldest and most renowned universities in Europe.



Today it has a population of over 55,000 students, of whom almost half are undergraduate students. In addition to its main campus in Leuven, the University has other campuses in Kortrijk, Antwerp, Ghent, Bruges, Ostend, Geel, Diepenbeek, Aalst, Sint-Katelijne-Waver, and in Belgium's capital Brussels.
