The university has 3 campuses in Ganesha, Jatinangor, Cirbon. The ITB Ganesha campus is the main campus whose role has been assigned as a Heritage Campus which is the hub for ITB's collaboration with national and international academic forces. The ITB Jatinangor Campus is designated as a campus that prioritizes the development of

research and education that contributes to the socio-economic development of West Java.

Institut Teknologi Bandung provides extensive recreational areas and activities for its students, including sports and dining areas, as well as a dedicated student activity centre providing for a wide range of interests. The city of Bandung itself is a major domestic tourist hub, and is popular with young people for its retail environment and nightlife.
