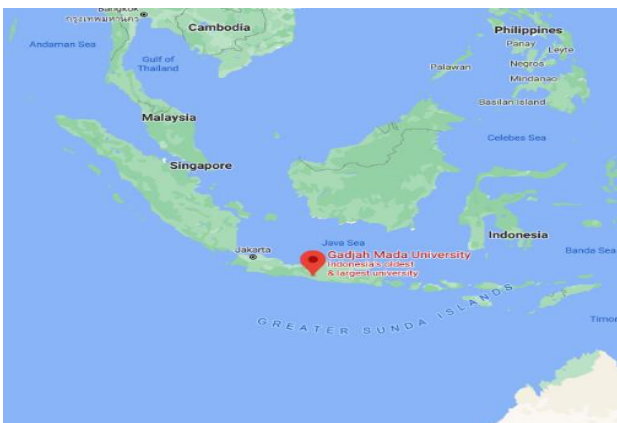

The University was officially established in Yogyakarta in 1949 as a national university. It has approximately 55,000 students, 1,187 foreign students and 2,500 faculty members currently. Universitas Gadjah Mada has been considered to be one of the most prestigious universities in Indonesia.

The university provides a wide range of scholarships including educational assistance scholarship for the underprivileged students, both domestically and abroad, as well as merit scholarship granted by the government and private sectors.
