Founded in 1868, the University of California, Berkeley (UCB) is a public research university and the flagship institution of the ten research universities affiliated with the University of California system.



It has a total undergraduate enrollment of 31,780, its setting is city, and the campus size is 1,232 acres. The school offers over 350 degree programs in 130 academic departments and 80 interdisciplinary research units.

The school offers more than 1,200 student clubs and organizations, from student government to advocacy groups, from traditional Greek life to the Peace Corps, students can get involved with as many student organizations as their interests, schedule, and scholastic pursuits permit.
