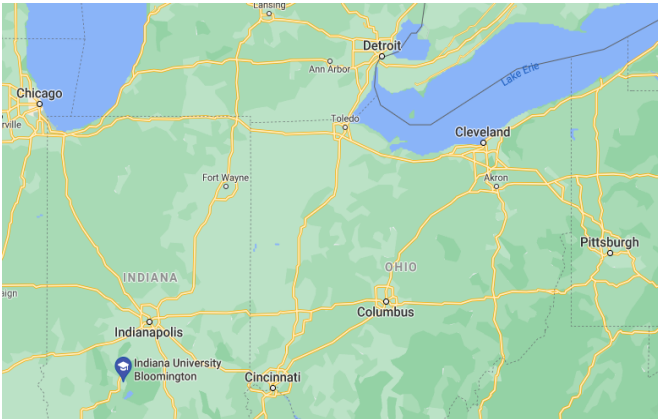

Indiana University was founded in 1825 and began to expand since 1921. Indiana University (IU) is located in the Midwest of America in the region of the Great Lakes. Its two main campuses are Bloomington and Indianapolis, with an additional six regional sites in Kokomo, Fort Wayne, Gary, New Albany, Richmond and South Bend.



The school has top ranked business and music school is home to the world's first school of philanthropy, the nation's first school of informatics, and the country's largest medical school.

Indiana University offers nursing to criminal justice, epidemiology to environmental science, social work to cybersecurity, and more than 900 academic programs. With over 110,000 students spanning all levels from undergraduate through to doctoral research and practice, the university has nearly 8,000 acres of land including on- and off-campus.
