Universitas Indonesia has two campuses - one is in the central business in Jakarta (Salemba), and the other one is located in Depok. The main campus in Depok now houses the majority of the faculties, including mathematics and natural sciences, humanities, economics and many more.

In an attempt to decrease the number of vehicles in the campus, over 20 kilometres of bicycle paths have been created, while shuttle buses are also provided. The university provides many sports facilities including a football stadium, athletic track, hockey field and tennis courts. Recently, the school produces more than 400.000 alumni and continues its important role both nationally and internationally.
