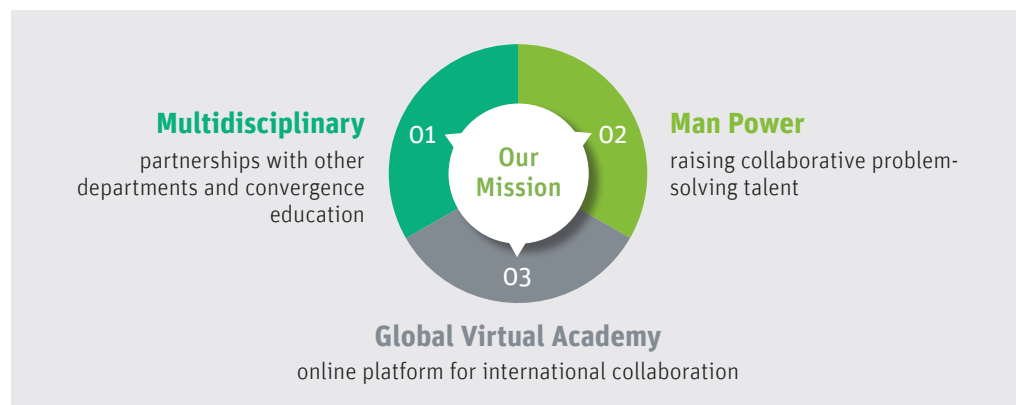


About the department
